## SAVE A TREE!



If you want to print out the assignments of each week from the Web, how should you do this?

**DO NOT press the printer icon **P** in Internet Explorer** to do this. The printer icon on the toolbar will print out the entire set of assignments beginning with Day 1, a very wasteful, expensive, and time-consuming process when all you really need is the most recent assignments.

**INSTEAD**, use Option 1:

1. With your mouse, click and drag the highlighting over the text you want to print.
2. Click on **Print** under the File menu, then choose **Selection** (in the Print Range box) by clicking on the radio button to the left.
3. Click OK to print.

**OR** Option 2:

1. When you find the assignments you want to copy, click and drag the highlighting over the text.
2. Click Edit in the toolbar to **Copy** the text to the clipboard.
3. Then open your word processor (e.g. MS Word or Corel WordPerfect) and click Edit in the toolbar to **Paste** the text onto your page.
4. Print your word processor page.
