

# Final Recording

1. For your Gray recording assignment you will record these materials:
  - a. Your personal GAT/SAT lists
  - b. Your Focus Text
  - c. Rows 12-24 from the Vowel Review
2. Before you begin recording, prepare yourself by doing the following:
  - a. Go back to your personal “Areas for Special Work” to see which problems need special attention. Note any instances of these areas in your materials.
  - b. Rehearse your materials aloud, carefully listening to and checking yourself for accuracy and clarity.
3. Make your recording in the following way:
  - a. Personal GAT/SAT lists
    1. Begin your recording by saying, “GAT list Column 1...Column 2...” etc.
    2. Go *down* each column, starting with the GAT list.
    3. Record each word twice.
  - b. Focus Text
    1. Begin your recording by saying “Focus Text”.
    2. Read your text one time
    3. If you want to rerecord any word, phrase or sentence, you may do so without starting over. Simply say, “Again” and then rerecord the part.
  - c. Rows 12-24 of Vowel Review
    1. Begin your recording by saying “Vowel Review”.
    2. Read *across* the rows, announcing each row number as you begin it.
    3. Read each word once.
    4. If you need to repeat a word, give the column letter. Simply say, for example, “F again” or “K again”.
4. When you finish the recording, check to see that you have made a clear recording.
5. Your recording will contribute to your grade in the course. So take the time to prepare it well. When evaluating the recording, the instructor will pay attention to your “Areas for Special Work” to see how much progress you have made in these areas. Clear demonstration of progress is expected.
